The USMMA-AF – Chesapeake Chapter established a new legal entity - the USMMA KP Alumni – Chesapeake Chapter, Inc. – as a NONSTOCK Corporation in the State of Maryland, as per the Articles of Incorporation; and stated that the USMMA KP Alumni – Chesapeake Chapter, Inc. shall be the sole representative organization of the predecessor USMMA-AF – Chesapeake

Chapter, as a voting member of the of the USMMA KP Alumni - Chapter Presidents Alliance, Incorporated.

This business form is the most appropriate for our Chapter, as we are engaged in our fraternal enterprise. This business form will provide us with the structure required to operate as a legal entity, and to limit the liability exposure of the officers, directors and members of the Chesapeake Chapter.
