7... MARITIME INDUSTRIES ACADEMY HIGH SCHOOL BALTIMORE - INSTRUCTOR POSITION

GENERAL DESCRIPTION: Maritime Industries Academy is an urban public school in Baltimore, Maryland that serves approximately 450 students in grades 9-12. Enrollment is expected to grow to 600. Assist in administration of USCG student MMD documentation program.

Participate and instruct in the maritime jobs and intern program.

Assist with the student apprentice program.

Supervise and accompany students on field trips both ashore and afloat in connection with the maritime curriculum.

Bachelor's Degree in an appropriate discipline related to maritime studies such as marine transportation, oceanography, engineering, or naval architecture.

Excellent communication and leadership skills.

Skilled in the use of computer based office/business applications (i.e. Microsoft Office)

USCG License as Third Mate or Third Assistant Engineer

*Exceptional candidates who do not meet minimum qualifications may be considered with significant maritime experience.
