2... “The Port that Built a City and State” Premiere at Baltimore Museum of Industry 102509

The Baltimore Museum of Industry (BMI) invites the public to the premiere of The Port that Built a City and State, a 60th anniversary documentary video about Baltimore’s historic long running maritime TV series. Aris Melissaratos, Senior Advisor to the President of Johns Hopkins University will serve as Master of Ceremony for the event. This special event will be Sunday, October 25, 2009 from 2:00 to 5:00 p.m. in the museum. BMI Executive Director Roland Woodward says, “Watching this film footage is something like seeing Aubrey Bodine’s iconic black & white photos of Baltimore and the Port come to life.”

The documentary was created from over 150 hours of 16 mm film that has been in storage in the BMI archives and has not been seen by the public since the program’s final broadcast in 1965. A grant from the Port Tricentennial Committee in 2007 made this documentary possible to make the DVD’s available to the public,.

As part of this project, veteran Maryland Broadcaster Alan Walden interviewed Helen Delich Bentley about her historic TV series in sessions videotaped by the Wicklein Group. The interview touches on the highlights of the 15 years Mrs. Bentley and her film crew produced weekly stories on the Port, its people, its influences and the needs and issues of the day. Various topics from the interview are seen on the DVD including the Old Bay Line, Domino Sugar, tugboats, bay pilots, the frigate Constellation, the B&O Railroad, A. Aubrey Bodine, the Harbor Tunnel, Bethlehem Steel, Liberty Ships, the creation of the Port Authority and more. Film shot by Mrs. Bentley’s WMAR-TV crew and kinescopes of the original broadcasts have been edited to illustrate stories about the port, its people and how the shows were produced in the early days of TV. Woodward said that, “It was a unique program in American television and the preserved films are a priceless look at Baltimore, the port and the state of Maryland.”

Mrs. Bentley and the documentary’s editor Mike Wicklein, will give some background on the documentary and then will entertain questions from the audience. The 45 minute video shown at the premier will be included in a 60th Anniversary DVD set which will be available for purchase. The set includes a 60 minute history of the port that was produced in 1954 for the TV series and some additional excerpts from The Port that Built the City programs that are part of the BMI’s new digital tours. In addition, memorabilia will be on display related to Ms. Bentley’s role as host to the show.

Our First Annual KP Chesapeake Upland Game Hunt & Luncheon will be conducted as a Half-Day Pheasant Hunt. This selection of the largest upland game bird will maximize the opportunity for the success of our hunting party members! A field guide and hunting dogs will be provided to each party.

This hunting preserve provides upland game hunting as it used to be in the "good old days". They provide ring-necked pheasants which are released on their farm, per our request, before we arrive. We are hunting over a 350 acre crop and dairy farm. The farm includes a terrain mixed with natural rolling hills, flowing streams, thickets, wooded areas, and medium grasses. Only one group is allowed to hunt on the farm at a time, and the hunting preserve has been reserved for our KP Chesapeake Hunters!

The KP Chesapeake Hunters will assemble at the Hunting Lodge no later than 7:45AM for our Field Breakfast, Orientation, Licenses, Shotguns, and Ammo. Our Half -Day Hunt will commence at 8:00AM and conclude at 11:00AM, with luncheon provided thereafter. Weather is not an issue, except in the case of a downpour.

Hunters are encouraged to wear comfortable walking boots, a shell vest with game bag, a blaze orange article of clothing, rain gear, and to bring a light, quick handling shotgun. LBRA will provide shotguns upon advance request if needed. The preserve also has Beretta shotguns for rental if you desire. Bird cleaning is available with advance notice (\$2/bird).

Administrator Matsuda's Biography:

David T. Matsuda - Acting Maritime Administrator/Deputy Maritime Administrator

David T. Matsuda was appointed Deputy Maritime Administrator by President Obama on July 28, 2009, and was officially sworn into office on July 30, 2009.

Mr. Matsuda served as the U.S. Department of Transportation's Acting Assistant Secretary for Transportation Policy from March 2009 until his appointment as Deputy. Prior to that, he spent seven years on Capitol Hill. While working in the U.S. Senate, Mr. Matsuda was engaged in the formulation and debate of most major Federal transportation legislation as senior counsel and primary transportation advisor to U.S. Senator Frank R. Lautenberg of New Jersey.

In 2002, Mr. Matsuda became a Georgetown University Government Affairs Institute Fellow serving on the staff of the Senate Committee on Commerce, Science and Transportation. From 1998 to 2002, he worked as an attorney with the safety law division of the USDOT's Federal Railroad Administration.

Mr. Matsuda's hometown is Apple Valley, California. He earned his B.S. in engineering from Harvey Mudd College in

Claremont, CA, and his J.D. from the University of San Diego School of Law in San Diego, CA. He lives with his wife Catherine Parsons Matsuda in Washington, DC
